The [Push for Change Hockey Challenge](#) in South Bruce will bring former NHLers to the area to promote awareness of youth homelessness.

The game takes place on Saturday, Feb. 18, 2017 from 1-3 p.m. at the Kincardine Davidson Centre arena.

Three teams comprised of the South Bruce OPP, Kincardine Fire and Emergency Services and KDSS Knights will each be comprised of both staff and students from the high school.

The match will feature periods, similar to a round robin format, with each team playing a different opponent for a

period.

The three teams will be captained by a former NHL player, Greg de Vries (Stanley Cup winner with Colorado Avalanche 2000-2001), Mark Bell and Boyd Devereaux.

All three have agreed to arrive early and stay late to speak with the public for autographs and photos.

Joe Roberts is the man behind Push for Change and a former homeless addict who is currently pushing a shopping cart across Canada an end for youth homelessness.
