Roberts is pushing a shopping cart across Canada to bring awareness to youth homelessness.

"Tens of thousand of young people across Ontario, and right across this country are finding their own unique way to push for change. It's really been the heart beat of this movement."

Roberts arrived in Kenora this afternoon, and he will be speaking at Seven Generations tomorrow.

He adds making it to Kenora is a milestone.

"We can't believe we are almost done Ontario. Ontario is a 36 hundred kilometer walk. Kenora represents that last big event before we enter into Manitoba so we are going to get an opportunity to hand off to the RCMP and say good bye to our good friends."

Roberts will wrap up his visit in Kenora on Saturday morning at a fish fry.
