

# Push for Change Stops at CASS

Today Grade 6, 7 and 8 students came out to Highway 17 to walk Joe Roberts and his shopping cart into CASS, where he would talk to them about his push for change to eliminate youth homelessness and poverty.

Today was day 271 for Joe pushing his way across Canada, from east to west. He stopped at schools in Thessalon and Bruce Mines earlier this morning on his way to CASS.

Joe has walked with his cart a total of 5025 km and is well over half way to completing his goal of 9000km.

CASS students will be collecting items such as mittens, hats, socks and toiletries until the end of next week. All items donated will be delivered to Pauline's Place in Sault Ste. Marie, which is a shelter for youth.

East Algoma OPP collected canned goods, toys, clothing and other donations throughout Algoma during December, in support of The Push For Change and those in need locally.
